## The Puppy Wellness Plan

Congratulations on the addition of a new puppy to your family! The doctors and staff at College Village Animal Clinic are excited to help you provide the best care possible for



your new family member. We have developed our puppy plan to include all the necessary exams, vaccinations, de-worming and lab tests needed to get your puppy started on a long and healthy life. Keeping your new puppy happy and healthy is important and we are here to help you along the way. Our puppy wellness plan represents substantial savings on veterinary services during the first year of your pet's life.

### **WELL PUPPY OFFICE VISITS**

At each visit, the doctor will perform a complete physical exam to evaluate your puppy for any signs of illness. During these visits, the doctor and the staff will cover many different topics important to your puppy's health and development including: behavioral counseling, housetraining, nutrition, oral care and the benefits of spaying/neutering. These visits are a great opportunity for you and your puppy to get to know the doctors and staff at CVAC and to get answers to the questions you may have.

### **VACCINES**

**DHLPP (Distemper/Parvo)** This is a vaccine combination containing distemper, adenovirus, leptospirosis, parainfluenza, and parvovirus. These are viruses that can cause respiratory, liver kidney and intestinal disease. They are all quite contagious and difficult to treat.

Bordetella (Kennel Cough) This vaccine protects your puppy against the bacteria Bordetella bronchiseptica, which is part of the kennel cough complex. We recommend this vaccine even if your dog doesn't board at a kennel or get groomed. Even nose to nose interaction through a fence can spread kennel cough.

**Rabies** This is a fatal virus spread by the bite of an infected animal. Rabies is nearly untreatable in animals and humans once symptoms begin. This vaccination is required by law.

### **OTHER SERVICES**

**De-worming** Puppies are vulnerable to parasite infestations that can seriously threaten their health and that of your family. Our wellness package will provide three treatments of an oral dewormer given two weeks apart to protect against intestinal parasites.

Toe Nail Trims Most owners dread trimming their pup's nails. It looks difficult and, well, puppies are so wiggly! The truth is, nail trimming isn't difficult if you know how. We will help you get started early which will allow your puppy to get accustomed to having their nails trimmed.

### **LABORATORY TESTS**

Fecal Exam This tests for intestinal parasites. Unfortunately, puppies can acquire intestinal parasites from their mother before birth or while nursing. They also may become infected through parasite eggs in the feces of other animals. Some of the intestinal parasites puppies can get are transmissible to humans and possibly can cause serious disease. We perform this test in the clinic through a centrifugation process. This test allows us better evaluation and identification of parasite eggs in the feces.

Blood Panel At the final visit, we will draw a blood sample that is sent to an outside laboratory. This



test includes a complete blood count and a number of blood chemistries. The complete blood count will help the doctor to determine if your puppy is anemic (low red blood cell count) or has an infection (high white blood cell count). The chemistries will help the doctor evaluate your puppy's liver and kidney function. Changes in these values may be indicative of a congenital defect or problem that needs to be treated. If you plan to spay or neuter your puppy, this blood test is a great pre-operative screen before anesthesia.
